### TENANTS' RIGHTS LEGAL CLINICS

*Tenants' Rights Legal Clinics offer free legal advice, resources, information, intake & screening and system navigation on a walk-in basis to low-income King County residents facing landlord-tenant issues.*

Tenants will meet with a Housing Justice Project attorney one-on-one for a brief consult to discuss issues with your landlord including disputes over issues such as lockouts, move-out and move-in issues, discrimination, habitability and more.

IF YOU HAVE BEEN SERVED WITH A SUMMONS & COMPLAINT FOR UNLAWFUL DETAINER (EVICTION) DO NOT COME TO THESE CLINICS, PLEASE ATTEND YOUR SHOW CAUSE HEARING TO BE SCREENED FOR POSSIBLE REPRESENTATION.

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

*King County tenants at or below 200% of the federal poverty level or receiving public benefits, may walk in to these clinics. All attendees are screened for financial eligibility, conflicts and program capacity. All services are free.*

## LEGAL AID POP-UPS

*Do you have a question about a civil legal issue -- housing, family law, wills, consumer issues, general legal problems, etc.?*

*Legal Aid Pop-Ups are here for you. These are not staffed by attorneys and cannot offer legal advice but do provide free legal information, resources and system navigation on a walk-in basis at various locations around King County.*

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

*All King County tenants regardless of income who have questions about a civil legal issue may walk in to Legal Aid Pop-ups. All services are free.*
